Department: Administration

Background/Description of Item:

On Wednesday, December 11, 2024, the Colorado Municipal League (CML) provided an update on American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) obligations to CML Members. This update included an attachment of CML member cities who had ARPA funds remaining to obligate. Florence was not included on the Excel sheet, meaning all funds were counted as obligated.

In a follow-up email on Thursday, December 12, 2024, CML expounded on the Treasury's ruling, relaying a specific direction that the items identified for ARPA funding need to be under contract or have an associated work order. This added an additional step beyond the information provided in previous webinars and other informational materials from the Treasury Department, which had provided instruction that ARPA funding was to be officially budgeted towards a project or project in order to count as "obligated", a process which Staff has diligently followed.

During the 2024 Budget process, Council budgeted the vast majority of the City's remaining ARPA funding for use towards improvements to the Pioneer Park Restrooms and other facility improvements in Pioneer Park (including pool improvements which may be identified in the Pool Feasibility Study). Staff quickly determined it was not realistic for this project to be under contract by December 31, 2024, and immediately began looking at alternative means to ensure the City would be able to obligate the money prior to the deadline in order to ensure this irreplaceable funding would not be lost, losing these important upcoming community projects with it.

To that end, Staff worked to identify items that are either already contracted or can be placed under contract in advance of the December 31, 2024, deadline, and which can be paid for utilizing ARPA money. Staff developed parameters to ensure, to the greatest extent possible, ARPA funding is being utilized to pay for existing and/or pre-identified future needs, freeing up General Fund money in the future to pay for the Pioneer Park Projects. Staff did not want to add projects or items that were not previously budgeted, or would be considered future "wants", as this would defeat the purpose of ensuring the Pioneer Park projects would be able to receive funding from now freed-up General Fund money for completion.

These parameters are as follows:

- All suggested items must be from the General Fund; and
 - Note: both the Water Enterprise Fund and the Streets Fund, which utilizes the Special Sales Tax (Fund 17) are not eligible for receipt of ARPA Funding.
- All suggested items must be items which:
 - (a) Were budgeted in 2024; or

- (b) Are budgeted for 2025: or
- (c) Are items (including CIP items) Staff would have identified as "non-negotiables" in the 2026 budget
 - Note: While ARPA funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024, they
 need to be SPENT by December 31, 2026 Staff utilized this deadline to
 justify the inclusion of 2026 items as suggested items for the use of ARPA
 funding.

Utilizing these parameters, Staff was able to identify multiple items for potential ARPA funding. Many of these projects are part of existing contracts or payment structures and, as such, will not require Council approval. However, Council will also be presented with multiple items for their consideration during the December 31, 2024, Special Meeting in order to complete the process.

Additionally, Staff would like to openly address the timeline for this process, as this determination that a pivot away from the original plan for spending the ARPA funding was reached on Thursday, December 12, 2024, in advance of the passage of the final budget on Monday, December 16, 2024, in order to clarify why the budget did not reflect this change of course:

- Staff was still reviewing and determining if our threshold for obligation had actually been met at the time of the publication of the meeting packet (also on Thursday, December 12, 2024). Staff was in the initial stages of determining an action plan and path forward at this point and felt it was not prudent to begin dismantling the budget looking for items to redirect funding towards without first developing a plan of action.
- If Staff had chosen to dismantle and recreate the budget, it is unlikely every decision
 made would fully bear out. It was determined that it would be unrealistic to assume
 every item selected on the first pass through will be able to be contracted by the
 deadline, especially during the holidays when many businesses are operation with
 reduced hours and limited Staff. This means that the budget still would have likely
 been incorrect and required a budget amendment.
- Staff would not have been able to provide proper documentation and narration for the plan we were composing at that time, as it was just beginning to be formulated and put into review and ultimately action. With the limited turnaround between learning we would need to pivot and the release of the packet, Staff was not able to ensure the action we had chosen was appropriate, legal, and would resolve the situation prior to the release of the packet and passage of the final budget, and did not want to relay half-formed information that may have contained an unviable solution.

Long Chevrolet for the purchase of vehicles

Department: Administration

Staff Recommendation:

Authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts with Daniels Long Chevrolet for the purchase of (1) a Chevy Silverado 3500 with dump bed for use by the Public Works Department and (2) a Chevy Silverado 1500 for use by the Florence Police Department.

Background/Description of Item:

Staff recommends utilizing ARPA funding to pay for the purchase two (2) Vehicles:

- (1) Chevy Silverado 3500 with dump bed for use by the Public Works Department; and
- (2) Chevy Silverado 1500 for use by the Florence Police Department.

While Staff requested, and Council honored, a moratorium on vehicles until a fleet management program could be developed, the moratorium included exceptions for vehicles that had reached end-of-life and would cost more to repair and for a potential Police Vehicle.

The Chevy Silverado 3500 is intended to replace a current one-ton dump truck utilized by the Public Works Department that has reached end-of-life and would cost more to repair than it is valued at. The Chevy Silverado 1500 is intended to replace one (1) of the current vehicles in the Police Fleet, enabling the Police Department to have a functional loaner car for Officers when their car is in for repairs.

The 3500 would have been brought to Council as a request for purchase in early 2025. Staff was previously anticipating utilizing better-than-anticipated Fund Balance in the General Fund for this purchase once FY 2024 was fully closed out. The Police vehicle would have been budgeted for 2026 as a non-negotiable if not required for replacement before then.

Note: Staff anticipates the Police Vehicle would have been need in 2025; 2026 would have been best case scenario.

Staff developed parameters to ensure, to the greatest extent possible, ARPA funding is being utilized to pay for existing and/or pre-identified future needs, freeing up General Fund money in the future to pay for the Pioneer Park Projects. These parameters include being (1) General Fund items and (2) being budgeted items or items anticipated for inclusion in the 2026 budget (typically intended as non-negotiables or non-negotiable in spirit).

The suggested vehicle purchases fall within these parameters as they are (1) a General Fund item which (2a - 3500) would have been included in the 2024 or 2025 budget as a budget

amendment for an emergency purchase or (2b -1500) would have been included in the 2025 budget as an emergency purchase or in the 2026 budget as a non-negotiable purchase

Financial Impact:

- ARPA funding in the amount of \$133,897.00
 - \$80,110.00 for the Chevy Silverado 3500 with dump bed for use by the Public Works Department; and
 - \$53,787 for the Chevy Silverado 1500 for use by the Florence Police Department

Background/Description of Item:

Staff recommends utilizing ARPA funding to pay for the purchase of a pre-fabricated building to serve as a designated common area for the Public Works Department to use for additional storage, host meetings, and utilize for break space. This item has been included on the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) since the initial development of the CIP and has been identified by the City's insurer, Colorado Intergovernmental Risk Sharing Agency (CIRSA) as necessary moving forward in order to provide an eating/gathering area away from chemical and other storage at the current Public Works Building.

Staff developed parameters to ensure, to the greatest extent possible, ARPA funding is being utilized to pay for existing and/or pre-identified future needs, freeing up General Fund money in the future to pay for the Pioneer Park Projects. These parameters include being (1) General Fund items and (2) being budgeted items or items anticipated for inclusion in the 2026 budget (typically intended as non-negotiables or non-negotiable in spirit).

The suggested purchase falls within these parameters as it is (1) a General Fund item which (2) would have been included in the 2026 General Fund budget as a non-negotiable CIP project (see above information RE CIRSA).

Financial Impact:

• ARPA funding in the amount of \$29,460.68

Note: the original CIP estimate for this project was \$40,000 including interior finish work, much of which will be completed by Staff.

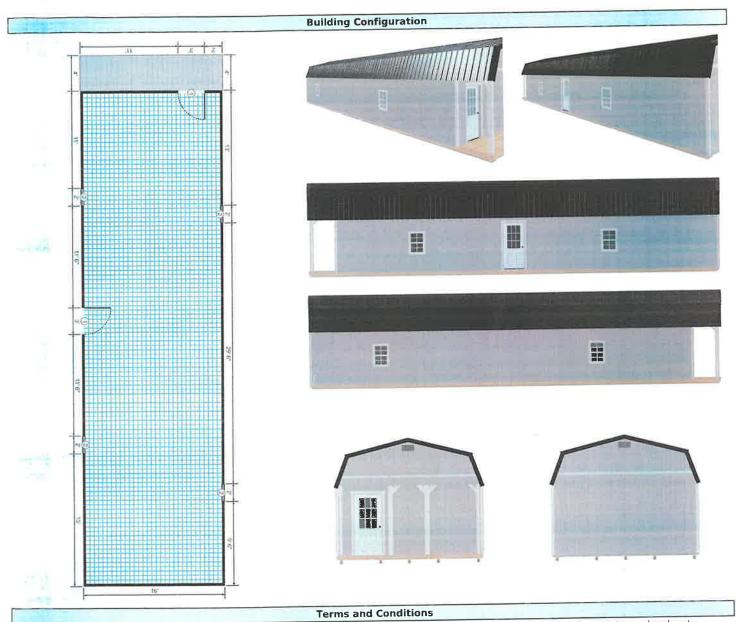

Authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts with Amnet for the purchase of (a) Ten (10) new Dell Pro Rugged laptops for the Florence Police Department and (b) Twelve (12) new desktop computers and six (6) new laptop computers for use by employees in multiple City departments, including, but not limited to, the Florence Police Department and Administration.

Background/Description of Item:

Staff recommends utilizing ARPA funding to pay for the purchase of new computer equipment:

- (a) Ten (10) new Dell Pro Rugged laptops for the Florence Police Department; and
- (b) Twelve (12) new desktop computers and six (6) new laptop computers for use by employees in multiple City departments, including, but not limited to, the Florence Police Department and Administration.

Most of the computer equipment utilized by the City of Florence has reached or surpassed endof-life. This causes multiple work-impact issues, including difficulties updating and difficulties with integrating to new versions of the software systems the City utilizes to perform daily operations of the City.

These problems are especially prevalent for the Florence Police Department, as changes to a new software system, Tyler, have caused ongoing issues with the Police Department's dated technology. Though the City was required to switch to Tyler in order to continue utilizing Combined Regional Communications Authority (CRCA) dispatch services, as CRCA switched to this platform, financial support for the purchase and installation of the Tyler system itself and for the equipment necessary to effectively utilize Tyler were not provided.

These prices include full installation support and warranties for the equipment.

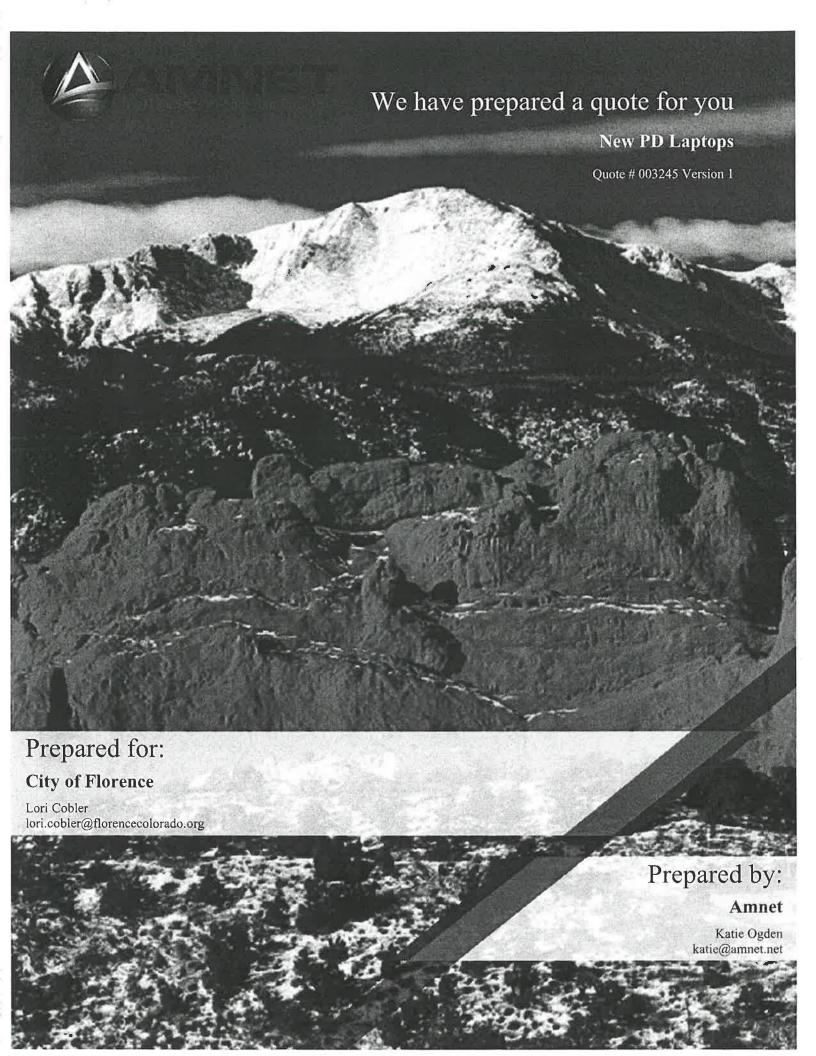

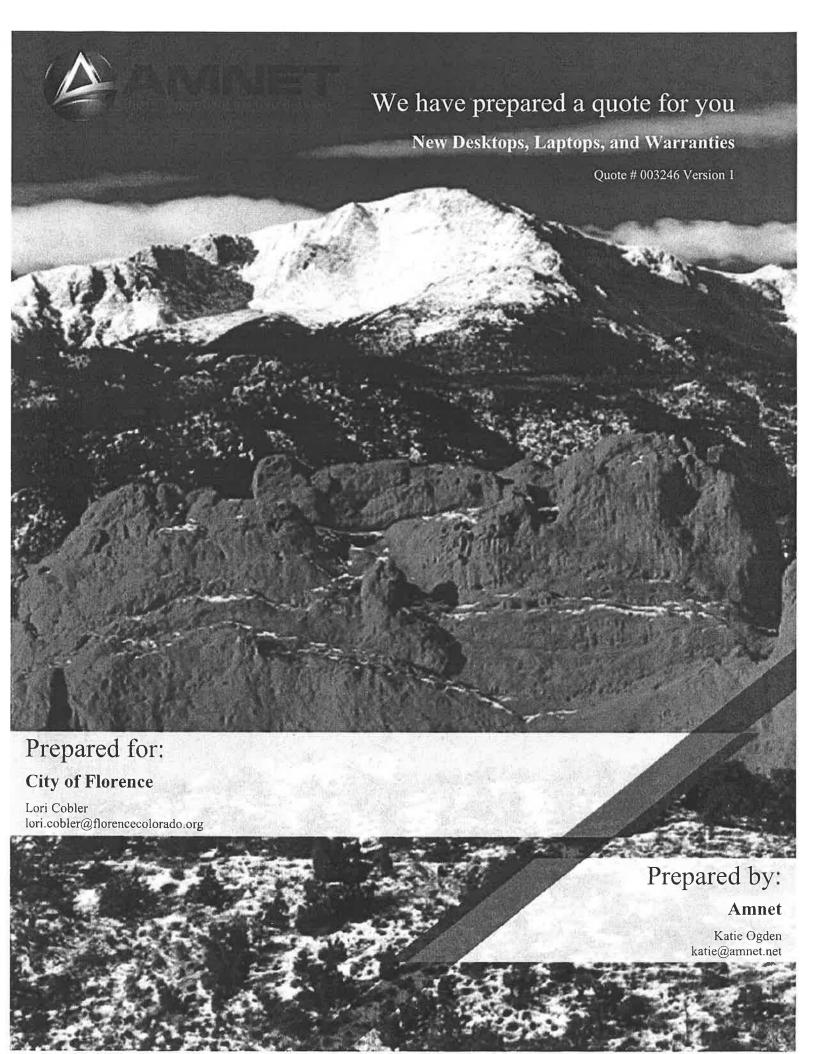

Staff Recommendation:

Authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts for replacement of the front entry doors at the Florence Municipal Building.

Background/Description of Item:

Staff recommends utilizing ARPA funding to pay for the replacement of the front entryway doors at the Florence Municipal Building and an electronic lock system for both the front door and the State Patrol (Council Chamber) door. This item has recently been identified as an issue for safety and security reasons and was slated for inclusion as a necessary CIP project for 2026 if need did not dictate completion in advance of this date.

Staff developed parameters to ensure, to the greatest extent possible, ARPA funding is being utilized to pay for existing and/or pre-identified future needs, freeing up General Fund money in the future to pay for the Pioneer Park Projects. These parameters include being (1) General Fund items and (2) being budgeted items or items anticipated for inclusion in the 2026 budget (typically intended as non-negotiables or non-negotiable in spirit).

The suggested purchase falls within these parameters as it is (1) a General Fund item which (2) would have been included in the 2026 General Fund budget as a non-negotiable CIP project (see above information RE safety).

 - o Interior Door \$5,000
 - Electronic locks on both the front State Patrol entrances \$7,205
